The entrance is through what used to be Johnstone House but it's been totally refurbished and sympathetically modernised so that even those of us that knew it well barely recognise it.

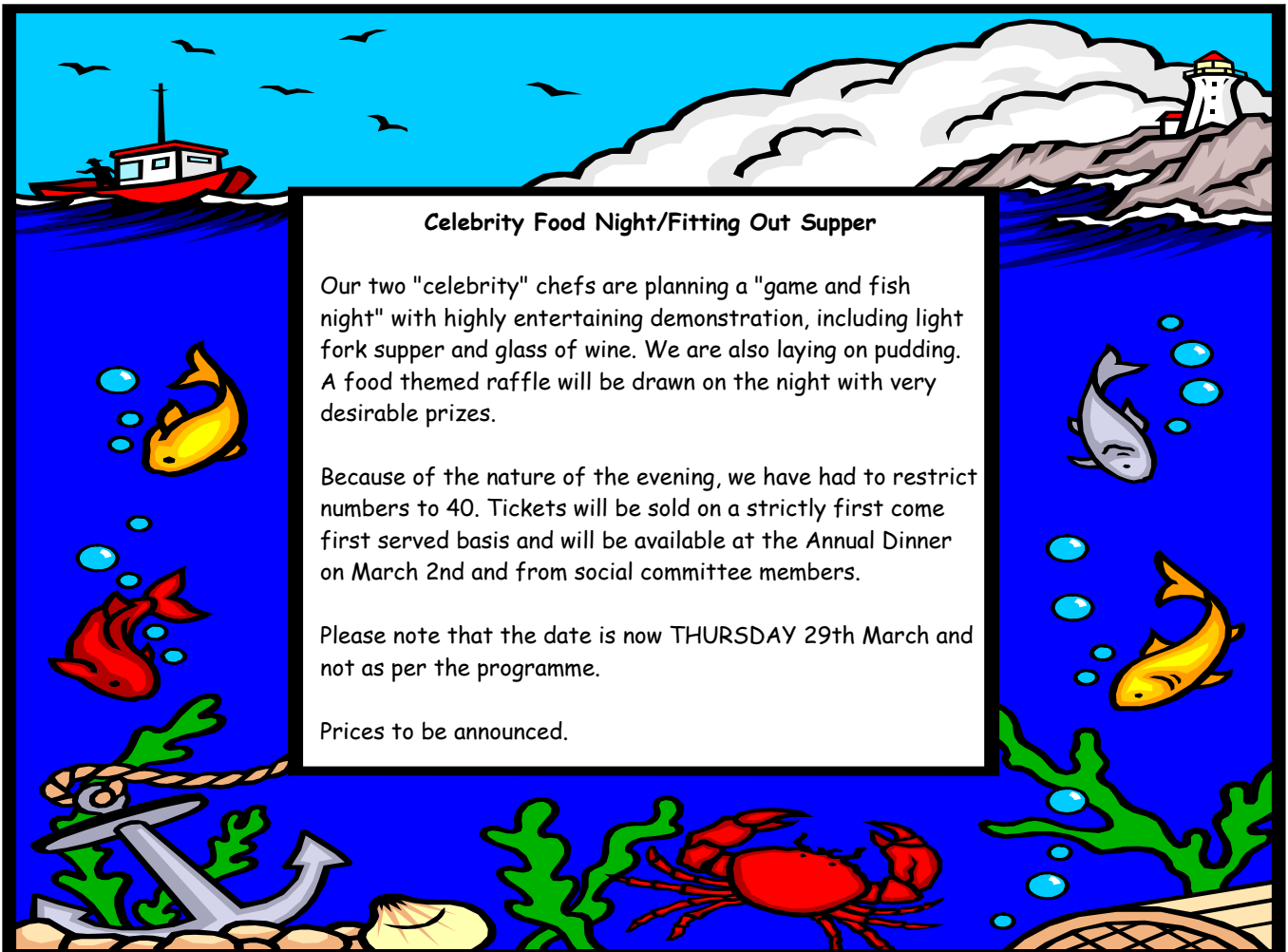
Celebrity Food Night/Fitting Out Supper
