

ANNANDALE SAILING CLUB  
Terms and Conditions of Group Membership

General

Group membership is offered to bodies that wish to introduce their members to the sport of sailing and Annandale Sailing Club (ASC).

ASC expects interested members of the group to be encouraged to apply for individual membership of the club to entitle them to participate in club activities.

A group shall appoint a group leader and an assistant group leader. These individuals shall be responsible for all group activities.

The ASC Committee shall nominate relevant committee members as points of contact for group members.

Annual Meeting

The group leader and assistant group leader shall meet with the relevant members of the ASC Committee annually before activities commence to discuss their plans for the season.

The group leader shall detail plans for any regular activity at this annual meeting and the commencement of the activity will follow agreement by the ASC Committee.

Prior to the commencement of any activity not discussed at this annual meeting, the group leader and/or assistant group leader shall meet with relevant members of the ASC Committee.

At the annual meeting, the group leader and assistant will be updated to any changes to ASC documents to which they must adhere.

Storage of Equipment

Group members are not entitled to store any private equipment in the ASC clubhouse, boathouse or boatpark.

In certain circumstances the storage of equipment may be agreed on an annual basis, this must be detailed at the annual meeting and agreed by the ASC Committee.

The short term storage of any equipment must be agreed with the relevant members of the ASC Committee described above.

Facilities and Equipment

Group members are expected to treat all ASC facilities respectfully. Group members are expected to leave all areas of the clubhouse, boathouse and boatpark clean, tidy and safe. The group leader and/or assistant group leader are responsible for ensuring this.

Group members are entitled to hire ASC equipment. They are expected to treat all equipment with respect and store them in the appropriate manner. Any problems with equipment must be reported to the relevant Committee member of ASC immediately.

A hire charge for equipment and payment arrangements will be agreed at the annual meeting.

The use of private equipment must be agreed at the annual meeting and the group leader is expected to provide proof of insurance. All private equipment must be checked regularly for compliance with buoyancy and safety requirements.

Safety Policy

It is essential that group members comply with the ASC Safety Policy at all times. All responsible members of the group must be familiar with the policy and will sign a statement to that effect.
